Friday Morning Breakfasts (Order and pick-up donuts, bagels, fruit, and juice and/or coordinate and solicit donations)	
Awards (Coordinate ordering trophies, picking them up, and setting up for end-of-year awards ceremony)	
Awards Banquet (Plan and organize potluck dinner for end-of-year awards ceremony)
